Please accept our invitation to join us and the outdoor community in our upcoming celebration of Lincoln's trail heritage on Sunday, August 11, 2019. We will celebrate the first annual Lincoln Trails Day as the premier Trail City in Montana.

The community of Lincoln will be hosting Trails Day in conjunction with our renowned Annual Art and Music Festival, August 10-11, 2019. The goal of Lincoln's Trails Day celebration is to highlight our unique geography along the Continental Divide. The Lincoln area was a unique trail area long before Lewis and Clark passed through, as Natives Americans have used the Cokahlarishkit Trail for thousands of years. Today Lincoln maintains this unique trail heritage and is now an integral trail town for the Continental Divide Trail (CDT), the Great Divide Mountain Bike Route (GDMBR), The Lewis and Clark Trail, the Race to the Sky and our newest, the Montana Trail 406 that has its genesis right here in Lincoln!

We are blessed here in Lincoln by a wealth of outdoor opportunities and we intend to celebrate them during Trails Day August 11th. This event will be an opportunity for you to introduce your organization and products to the global outdoor community and the growing number of outdoor enthusiasts recognizing Lincoln's unique geography as the premier Montana Trail City.


on Sunday at 9am and a donation only barbeque hosted by the Lincoln Valley Chamber of Commerce will be available in the afternoon. Camp spots are available.
