

**DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO BOB MARSHALL WILDERNESS OUTFITTERS CORRALS, NORTH FORK OF THE BLACKFOOT TRAIL HEAD:**

Starting from MT-200 E - Ovando/Monture Trail Head crossroads

1. Head **SOUTHEAST** on **MT-200 E** toward Kleinschmidt Flats Road  
6.6 miles
2. Turn **LEFT** onto **KLEINSCHMIDT FLATS RD** – go 2.3 miles
3. Turn **RIGHT** onto **DRY GULCH RD** – go 2 miles
4. Turn **LEFT** onto **COOPER-BLACKFOOT RD** – go approximately 13 miles – cross the second bridge – take **IMMEDIATE LEFT** – go through the Forest Service gate – that will be unlocked and open – go up the hill – at the top of the hill – Bob Marshall Wilderness Outfitter corrals are on your left behind a row of trees – **park your car by the beige cement block pump house**. *Please do not block the roadways entering or exiting the corrals so the trucks with trailers may maneuver, thank you.*
