



**ATTENTION:**

Serious injury or even death can result from horse riding and related activities including any and all aspects of trail maintenance or reconstruction. There are risks inherent in equine activities, and these dangers or conditions that are an integral part of equine activities include, but are not limited to: A) The propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury or harm to, or death of persons on or around the equine; B) The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as medication; sound; sudden movements; and unfamiliar objects, persons or other

animals: C) Hazards, such as surface and subsurface ground conditions: D) Collisions over the equine or to not act within the person's ability. E) Participants in any activity shall act in a safe and responsible manner at all times to avoid injury to themselves and others, and shall be aware of the risks inherent in equine activities.

The **Selway-Pintler Wilderness Back Country Horsemen of Montana**, a non-profit organization, it's Board of Director's or any member thereof, shall not be liable for injury to or death of a participant (and/or their equine) or damage to any personal possessions as a result of their voluntary participation in any sponsored activity.
